Day 1: Monday, March 22

Included Meals: On your own today

Load the coach and depart for **Columbia, SC** and overnight.

Day 2: Tuesday, March 23

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning you travel to **Charleston, SC**. First, enjoy a self guided tour of the garden and grounds at the **Magnolia Plantation**. The gardens at **Magnolia Plantation** are of such beauty and variety that they have brought tourists from around the world to view them since they were open to the public in the early 1870's. However, many parts of the gardens are much older, some sections more than 325 years old, making them the oldest unrestored gardens in America. As the plantation has stayed within the ownership of the same family for more than three centuries, each generation has added their own personal touch to the gardens, expanding and adding to their variety. You will step back in time with a guided tour of the **Drayton** family home, the third to grace the site in more than three centuries of Drayton family occupation. In the current main house the core was built prior to the **Revolutionary War** near **Summerville, South Carolina** and floated down the **Ashley River** to **Magnolia** after the **Civil War**. It gives a glimpse of plantation life in the 19th century and beyond. Lunch is at **Virginia's Kitchen**, named for **Virginia Bennett**, the mother of one of the owners, serving up the cooking of their family table. This afternoon enjoy a narrated **Harbor Cruise** and discover how fresh sea air, incredible harbor views and the history of the **Old South** can turn your tour of the harbor into a memorable event. You will have a leisurely cruise past the palatial homes of **Charleston's** famous **Battery**, the **Cooper River Bridge**, **Waterfront Park**, **Patriots Point**, **Fort Sumter**, **Fort Moultrie** and the bustling seaport. Before checking into your hotel a wonderful dinner is planned for you at the **Old Post Village Restaurant & Inn**. Among the moss-draped oaks of the **Old Village of Mt. Pleasant** you can dine and relax in the Old tradition of the post house -- wayside inns where travelers stopped overnight for good food and friendly conversation.

Day 3: Wednesday, March 24

Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

The day starts with a **Carriage Tour** of **Charleston**. During the one hour tour you will experience 25 blocks of the historic downtown district. You will see houses, gardens, mansions, churches and parks and learn about buildings, history, architecture and people. Next, enjoy browsing and exploring the unique shops at the **City Market**. Sweet grass basket weavers can be seen in every building, along with local artists, jewelry, tapestry, souvenirs, church dolls, afghans, rugs, rice, beans and sauces, local candies, cookies and much more. This afternoon you will have a **Glorious Garden Tour**. These three hour walking tours are arranged so guests may leisurely stroll through eight to ten private, secret gardens. Guides are stationed in each garden to introduce you to its design, plant material and history. Dinner tonight is at the **Slightly North of Broad** restaurant, a 19th century brick warehouse located just north of historic **Broad Street**. The award-winning chef starts with the **Carolina Low Country's** rich resources and then adds his own blend of flavors from **Charleston's** multicultural heritage.

Day Four - Thursday, March 25

Meal: Breakfast

After breakfast the group will start their journey home.
