Day 1 – Saturday, September 8

Included Meal: Dinner

You will get to know your traveling companions today and enjoy the scenery as we travel to **Independence, MO** and overnight. There will be rest stops and meal breaks en route. You will have dinner before checking into your hotel for the evening.

Day 2 – Sunday, September 9

Included Meal: Breakfast

As you travel to **Colorado Springs** today, you'll have lunch on your own and a short visit at the **Eisenhower Museum and Library** in **Abilene, KS** before traveling on to your hotel in **Colorado Springs**. Evening on your own.

Day 3 – Monday, September 10

Included Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

You will visit the **U.S. Air Force Academy** an accredited college for the undergraduate education of officer candidates for the United States Air Force. Next you are off to **Garden of the Gods**, a 1323-acre registered National Natural Landmark of both scenic splendor and recreational opportunities. Imagine dramatic views, 300 foot towering sandstone rock formations against a backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak and brilliant blue skies. Enjoy lunch at the **Garden of the Gods Trading Post** and some free time for shopping. Dinner tonight will be at **Iron Springs Melodrama Dinner Theatre**. Begin your evening with a family-style dinner and then enjoy a fun-filled melodrama with audience participation strongly encouraged! After the melodrama, a foot-stomping sing-along and vaudeville olio full of song, dance and comedy continues the fun throughout the evening. After this you will return to the hotel for the night.



Day 4 – Tuesday, September 11

Included Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

After breakfast, board the coach, sit back and relax as you travel to **Santa Fe, NM** stopping for lunch on your own en route. Upon arrival a **local guide** will take you on a **guided tour of the Santa Fe**. Check into the hotel and freshen up before going out for a group dinner.

Day 5 – Wednesday, September 12

Included Meal: Breakfast

Once you have breakfast at the hotel you will travel to **Sedona**. On your way to Sedona, stop and visit the **Painted Desert**. The popular name for the desert comes from the Colonial Spanish who are said to have named it **El Desierto Pintado** due to its brightly colored landscape. Next you will enjoy a **guided tour of Sedona**. Hear the life stories of settlers who created this great community as it grew from an agricultural center of fifty people to the bustling tourism town it is today. You will learn about the real cowboys and the “reel” cowboys as Sedona’s ranching community entered the Golden Age of Western movies. Travel to **Flagstaff, AZ** and spend the night, evening on own.



Day 6 – Thursday, September 13

Included Meal: Breakfast & Dinner

Today you will travel to **The Grand Canyon**, enjoy touring with a local guide and lunch on your own here. This afternoon you’ll travel to **Bryce Canyon National Park**. The major feature of the park is **Bryce Canyon** which, despite its name, is not a canyon but a giant natural amphitheater created by erosion along the eastern side of the Paunsaugunt Plateau. A buffet dinner is planned tonight at your hotel.

Day 7 – Friday, September 14

Included Meals: Breakfast

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, before returning to **Bryce Canyon** for you to explore on your own. After seeing the park you will travel to **Evanston, WY**. Check into your hotel and have a relaxing evening on your own.

Day 8 – Saturday, September 15

Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Today you travel to **Grand Teton National Park** after breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a **guided tour of Grand Teton**. The Park consists of approximately 310,000 acres and includes the major peaks of the 40-mile long Teton Range as well as most of the northern sections of the valley known as Jackson Hole. Sit back and relax after the tour as you travel to the historic city of **Jackson Hole, WY**. After checking into your hotel you’ll have dinner before calling it a night.



Day 9 – Sunday, September 16

Included Meals: Breakfast

Fabulous scenery, canyons, geysers, wildlife, springs and the historic **Old Faithful** are in store for you today as you have a guided tour of **Yellowstone National Park**. Lunch will be on your own at one of the park’s facilities. After lunch you will travel to **Billings, MT**. Check into your hotel and enjoy an evening on your own in Montana’s largest city. With a trade area of over half a million people **Billings** is the largest metropolitan area between Denver and Calgary and between Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and Spokane, Washington.

Day 10- Monday, September 17

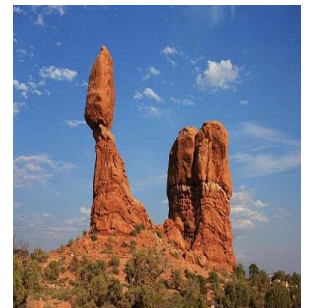
Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Day 12 – Tuesday, September 19

Included Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Have breakfast at the hotel before your **guided tour of Badlands National Park** and a visit to **Wall Drug**. After seeing the 244,000 acres of sharply eroded buttes, pinnacles, and spires blended with the largest protected mixed grass prairie in the United States you’ll continue your journey to **Mitchell, SD**. Once in Mitchell you will visit the **Corn Palace** which was originally called the Corn Belt

Exposition and established in 1892. Be sure to check out the murals on the building's exterior made with fruits of the harvest and designed by local artists. A farewell dinner is planned tonight after checking into your hotel.

Day 13 – Wednesday, September 20

Included Meal: Breakfast

Load coach and travel to **Independence, MO** to visit the **Harry S. Truman Library and Museum**. Then travel to **Columbia, MO** and overnight as you make your way back home.



Day 14 – Thursday, September 21

Travel home with meals and rest stops en route.
